Guide to the Use & Installation

Product Description

Pavetuf Straight Edge is the perfect choice for edging our Luxigraze Artificial Grass, lawns, borders, flower beds and pathways giving a neat garden appearance with perfect straight lines, crisp corners, gentle curves and shapes. Pavetuf Straight Edge gives a defining break between different materials such as gravel, lawns, paving, bark, mulch and much more.

Pavetuf Straight Edge is manufactured from aircraft grade aluminium alloy designed to last at least 25 years, meaning it is very low maintenance with no painting, staining or rusting to worry about. Held securely in place with barbed Fixing Stakes, it is light and easy to handle with a unique telescopic design to make installation quick and easy. Featuring a rounded top edge which will not damage lawn mower blades and a castellated body which gives maximum strength for heavy lawn mowers and prevents lifting by frost.

A heavy-duty version gives extra thickness for projects that need even more strength than the standard Pavetuf Straight Edge.

Application

Preparation

Dig a small trench approximately 5cm wide and 10cm deep in the position required.

Choose your jointing method

Pavetuf Straight Edge's unique telescopic design allows you to simply slide one piece inside the other. We recommended approximately 50mm overlap on each joint.

Alternately for flush fit joints use the flush joint piece behind each joint which slide in place. Packs of flush joining pieces can be purchased separately.

For curves

If laying with a gentle curve form the curve to the shape and design you require. Avoid forming curves and bends at stake locations as it will be more difficult to pass stakes through the stake pocket.

For angles

For sharp angles use a piece of 4" x 2" timber or the end of a work bench, measure and line up where you want the bend to be, hold or clamp the Pavetuf Straight Edge down and swiftly push down on the overhanging Pavetuf Straight Edge until the desired angle is achieved. When making cuts use a sharp scribe and cut with a hack saw.

Installation

Place the formed and jointed Pavetuf Straight Edge into the trench ensuring the stake pockets are located toward the lawn side and joint together with your preferred jointing method.

Check the height of the top edge of the Pavetuf Straight Edge, which should be 2-6mm above true ground level but beneath the required cut grass level.

Once you are happy with the shape and height fix in place by inserting the Fixing Stakes using a mallet.

Back fill with your chosen infill material.
