



MARSHALLS PERMEABLE PAVING INFORMATION

How is Priora laid?

Priora is not laid in the same way as conventional block paving. The sub-base, bedding course and jointing material needs to be an open graded aggregate to allow for water infiltration.

Which of the block paving products are permeable?

Any product which has "Priora" in the name are permeable – i.e. Drivesett Tegula Priora

If I have the Priora installed do I still need planning permission?

In most areas no, this is because you will be containing the water run-off within your property and not into the public highway. However it is always best to check with your local authority before any work starts.

Please also note that the legislation only refers to front gardens larger than 5m²

Can I seal Priora block paving?

Marshalls as a company believe it is not necessary to seal our block paving. This is due to many factors, the reasons being amongst others that:

1. Sealants have to be applied to a surface which is clean, dry & free from dust.
2. Sealants may affect the appearance of the units and wear unevenly.
3. Some sealants may clog/block the joints which could affect the water infiltration rate.

Are Priora blocks slip resistant?

All our paving is slip resistant provided that the units are maintained at the required intervals to prevent them from potentially becoming slippery with a surface build up of dirt, detritus and algae for example.

Do you have any permeable flags / paving?

Conservation Priora, Priora Permeable, Modal Priora

Can I lay permeable block paving on a sloped driveway?

It is possible to install permeable block paving on a slope, however there are various considerations to make and depending on the degree of slope.
